## UPDATE: Harvest of Hope Mission Programs canceled through 7/31/20

The Society of St. Andrew (SoSA) is a trusted community partner and has been for many years. All SoSA offices have maintained a strong commitment to ensuring only the best food is delivered to our recipients and partners.

Senior leadership at SoSA is carefully monitoring developments regarding the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus). We are staying informed on best practices and new developments as we continue our operations and distribute food to the people and communities we serve.

In response to the constantly evolving COVID-19 pandemic, **currently scheduled Harvest of Hope Mission Programs will be canceled through July 2020.**

Due to the nature of HoH events, and the general desire to build community among the participants, we deem it prudent to cancel the scheduled HoH events through July 2020. The situation will be reassessed and an announcement will be made in July 2020, regarding Fall 2020 Harvest of Hope events.

If you are interested in moving your reservation to one of our fall events we will happily accommodate your group.

If you choose not to attend a HoH event this year, please let us know whether you would like your deposit refunded, applied to another trip in 2021, or **redirected to SoSA's active food recovery and distribution efforts**. Your support is needed more than ever and can be especially powerful during this time of significantly increased hunger needs.
